

***** You must watch this video before meeting with the pastor the day of baptism*****

The following are the things you'll need and need to know for your baptism.

Meet at the baptism table 30 minutes before service. (Sunday at 8:30am for the 9:00am service or at 10:15am for the 10:45am service)

Things to Bring

1. A big towel to dry off with.
2. Flip flops to keep the carpet dry.
3. We will give you a LifeChurch tee shirt to wear when you arrive for your class.
 - a. (Women, please wear something under the tee shirt . Men & women please wear dark long shorts or leggings)
4. Dry clothes to change into and a bag to put your wet clothes in.
5. Camera for family or friend to use for your baptism.
6. If you have family/friends coming that have young children. Please encourage them to come early and check their children into KidsLife. If they would like to bring their children into service for baptism, please do so and bring the kids downstairs after.

What to Expect

1. Sit in the front 2 rows on the far right side of church.
2. As soon as the person before you comes out of the tub get up and start moving towards the tub yourself.
3. Be prepared to introduce yourself and give a quick testimony. (See below)
4. Bring your towel with you and give it to the "towel person" before you enter the baptismal. They will hand it to you as you exit.
5. As you pass by the chairs grab your dry clothes and go to the bathroom, upstairs or downstairs, to change.
6. Come back and enjoy the rest of the service.

Please be prepared to share a very quick personal testimony. It's an important part of making this a special event (For both you and your church family). YOU MUST prepare to share. The minimum required to say is that "Jesus Christ is My Lord and Savior". We're hoping you'll add a few personal details. The main point to share (at MOST in 6-7 sentences) is how Jesus has changed your life. Please keep in mind that children are in the audience and we want to keep it as positive as possible.
